Saturday morning we woke to sunshine again. Gaynor and John arrived - 11am and time for the AGM. We congregated in the hall for the final AGM at


Grace Dieu, very sadly due to a new ruling at the school. All passed without incident, and we then retreated outdoors to enjoy a cuppa and a get together.

TECHIE STUFF:

Calor Lite - Product Recall

As of 1st July 2017 the 2014 6kg Calor Lite recall, which required the return of all 6kg Calor Lite cylinders manufactured between 2008-2011 inclusive, will be closed. Should you still have a cylinder from the affected batch it will however still be swapped by your retailer on return for a replacement 6kg Calorlite or if one is not available then a standard 6kg cylinder. In either instance you will only need to pay for the gas.



HOW TO IDENTIFY A 6KG CALORLITE® CYLINDER FOR RECALL

Cylinders manufactured in 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011 are covered by the recall. The date of manufacture of the cylinder can be found in two places on the cylinder base ring:



In a box adjacent to the words 'Property of Calor Gas Ltd' there are two letters, then two numbers which denote the year of manufacture, followed by one letter.

Cylinders to be recalled are 08, 09, 10, and 11.

This example shows a manufacture date of 2010 i.e. AP 10 B.
