

Rally: The Royal Oak, Car Colston

Dates: Friday 8th June to Sunday 10th June

Directions:

From M1 Junction 26, take A52 towards Nottingham.

Keep on A52 till junction with A46 at Bingham.

Turn left onto A46.

Approx 3 miles north of Bingham turn east off A46 for 0.75 miles to Car Colston. Entering village on Tenman Lane, the Royal Oak is on the right across village green. (The site is behind the public house).

Local information:

The picturesque village of Car Colston has 29 acres of village greens and is believed to be the largest rural common in England. The building of The Royal Oak is about two hundred years old and is thought by some to have been a hosiery factory, hence the rather unusual vaulted brick ceiling in the bar which certainly would have carried the weight of the appropriate textiles machinery above.

Car Colston Cricket Club play on the village common every Sunday in summer months.

Bingham is close by and has the usual amenities.
